Eligible Dogs

This trial is open to all NATE registered dogs twelve (12) months of age or older. NATE registration can be done online at **www.nationaltreibball.com**. Exceptions are females in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Withdrawal for females in season must provide notice before the official start of the trial, and a refund will be given.

All dogs which have not participated in Indy Treibball Club trials will be height checked with wickets. Measurements will be done beginning at 7:30 and complete prior to the 8:00 start time.

Divisions

The A division is for dogs who have not earned a title at that level.

The B division is for dogs that have earned a Treibball Enthusiast title and are continuing to compete towards the Outstanding Treibball Enthusiast title in that level.

The Veteran divisions are for dogs 8 years and older.

Please note: Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Entry Form provided and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Awards

• Ribbons will be awarded for 1st thru 4th place.

Notice to the Exhibitors

- Cash or checks will be accepted as payment for entries. Checks should be made payable to Indy Treibball Club. Returned checks will not constitute valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Checks will be cashed after the closing date.
- If the trial does not fill, handlers will be permitted to make Day of Show entries in games they have already entered. This will be on a first come first serve basis up to the point the limit is reached.
- Day of show entries will cost \$18. Entries must be received no later than 7:30am, day of show.
- If a handler's dog damages a ball, the handler must pay a standard replacement fee for that ball by the end of the trial or forfeit qualifying runs and future trial/match entries by suspension.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all behaviors safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made. Minor children must be supervised

at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee.

- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, choke, and special training collars are prohibited on the Trial grounds. This includes bark collars. Head halters and no-pull harnesses are permitted on trial grounds but not in the warm-up, on-deck, or game field areas.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean future use. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- Waterproof barriers are to be placed beneath dog crates and chairs. Food and drink is prohibited on the new turf. There is a \$25 fee for any soiling of the new turf.
- **AVMA Statement**: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases.
